The link between St Peter's Church and the community of Kinver has evolved over the centuries. The first recorded Minster was Philip de Rous in 1189, though the Church goes back even further. It has been at the heart of many of life's events, including countless Weddings, Baptisms and Funerals.

It costs a lot to keep an ancient building like St Peter's up and running, and we are grateful for all the support that we receive.

Our income is generated in many and various ways. This may be through regular giving from the congregation, through fund raising events and initiatives both at the Church and in the Church Hall.

We also raise funds through membership of FOSPERS (see separate leaflet for more details), and the popular 100 Club and this is where you can come in!

About the 100 Club
